

Shared Events Terms and Conditions 2008

(Shared Summer Parties, Shared Christmas Parties, Veuve Clicquot Cruise and New Year's Eve Parties)

All bookings* can be held provisionally for 7 days, after which full pre-payment is required to secure the booking. Should the payment not be received within 10 days your booking will be automatically released, unless otherwise agreed by Silver Fleet in writing.

*except New Year's Eve Parties. Silver Fleet will not accept any provisional bookings for New Year's Eve parties. Full non-refundable payment must be made at the time of booking.

All cancellations must be communicated in writing to Silver Fleet by the party organizer. Silver Fleet will not accept any cancellations on the telephone after payment has been received.

Payments are strictly non refundable in all circumstances

Silver Fleet will reserve the right to refuse admission and remove from that service any persons, whose condition, in the opinion of Silver Fleet, interferes with, or is likely to interfere with, the enjoyment of the service by other participants. Silver Fleet does not accept any responsibility in respect of the person prevented from entering the event, or asked to leave due to their conduct.

It is your responsibility to ensure that all persons attending the event shall:

- comply with licensing, health and safety and other regulations relating to Silver Fleet
- not bring any dangerous or hazardous items aboard the vessels of Silver Fleet and to remove such items promptly when requested to do so by an authorised person.
- Not consume food or drink aboard the vessels of Silver Fleet not supplied by the caterers "rhubarb" on the river.
- Not act in any improper or disorderly manner, leave the vessels of Silver Fleet promptly at the appropriate time and comply with any reasonable request by Silver Fleet employees.

Advertised packages and offers are subject to availability. Silver Fleet reserve the right to make changes to the advertised elements of each party, but in doing so will undertake to offer a suitable alternative.

Silver Fleet reserves the right to cancel an event due to insufficient numbers, in which case an alternative date/ vessel or full refund of monies will be offered.

Silver Fleet does not accept any liability as a result of strikes, riots or lock-outs affecting any trade, adverse weather conditions or loss, damage or cancellation due to fire, flood or any other cause beyond its control.
